Oconee Joint Regional Sewer Authority Repeals Water Quality Advisory for Coneross Creek

SENECA, S.C. – The Oconee Joint Regional Sewer Authority (OJRSA) has repealed the water quality advisory issued on May 20, 2025, for Coneross Creek in Oconee County. The notice was issued as a precaution when wastewater was released from a broken pipe adjacent to the waterway near Cross Creek Plantation in Oconee County on Monday, May 19, 2025.

The OJRSA has analyzed samples from the affected waterway and results indicate the presence of bacteria returned to normal levels.

The South Carolina Department of Environmental Services (SCDES), formally known as the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC), has approved the repeal of the advisory based on the sample results.
