Question 1: Will there be any plan issued for this RFB?



Question 2 (Contains a consolidation of inquires. The OJRSA response is in bold font below):

Primary Sludge Diaphragm Pump - We propose the attached Gorman Rupp Diaphragm pump. Please advise if this is an acceptable equivalent.

Primary Scum Grinder Pump - Please provide additional information on the existing grinder pumps (existing make/model) as well as requirements for the new grinder pump – Discharge size, HP, Voltage, Flow (GPM), Pressure (FT of Head), etc. requirements. *Depending on what's existing, we will quote Liberty Engineered Products or Tsurumi grinder pumps*.

RAS Mag Meter - Please confirm if this will be an integral or remote flow meter (see below) and the length of cable that should be provided. *Please advise if Toshiba is an acceptable manufacturer. If so, please advise if 10 year warranty is required (standard from Toshiba)*:



Utility Water Pump - Please provide additional information on utility water pump requirements: discharge size, HP, Voltage, Flow (GPM), Pressure (FT of Head), etc. requirements. Existing Utility Water pumps are by Goulds – please advise if you'd like a pump identical to what is installed. Please confirm starter or VFD is currently installed and ready for this new pump.

Aeration Mud Valve Replacement - Please provide the sizes and required lay lengths or preferred manufacturers for the mud valves. We will propose McWane mud valves.

10 in Digester Sludge Valve Replacement - Please provide the model of the existing sludge valve and/or provide lay length information. We will quote Ross or Kennedy / Clow sludge valve.

4 in Digester Sludge Valve Cat Walk Replacement - Please provide make/model of existing valves and/or provide lay length information. We will quote Ross or Kennedy / Clow sludge valve.
